


## Job Corps Campuses



### Trust yourself

The idea of moving away from home may seem frightening at first. Or you may be looking forward to it. There are new things to get used to - moving to a new place, living in a dormitory, meeting new people - but trust yourself. You'll get used to the changes faster than you think. Before you know it, you'll feel right at home and be well on your way to getting a good job.

**Pittsburgh** - The center sits atop a wooded hill in the East Liberty section of Pittsburgh. Bus lines stop at the center. This is a large center, offering a very wide range of career choices, plus Allegheny County Community College Classes, serving 800 students. Many free time activities including; intramural sports, gym, weight lifting, billiards, field trips, movies, arts and crafts, etc. Also opportunities for community service, and working off center.

**Keystone** - At the base of the Pocono Mountains, near Hazelton, Pa, a 175 acre campus, serving 700 students, with a large selection of careers, including advanced classes at Luzerne County Community College. Thirteen dormitories, pool, gym, classrooms, and other support buildings. Many activities such as; basketball, dances, swimming, weight lifting, movies, bowling, arts and crafts, skiing, field trips, etc. Also community service and off center work.

**Red Rock** - A converted Air Force Radar Station high on a mountain in the Pocono Range (PA), serving 300 students, Red Rock is a medium size center. Surrounded by Ricketts Glen State Park, many of the free time activities are "nature oriented", as well as sports, gym, skiing, movies, art painting, etc. Part time work opportunities are limited. It will snow here.

**Charleston** - New facilities (June 1997) several miles outside downtown Charleston, West Virginia, 430 students, separate buildings for education, administration, vocational and dormitories. Extensive advanced programs. Work available for exemplary students.

Very limited openings for Pennsylvania students at these other centers: **Potomac**, Washington, DC; **Harpers Ferry**, Harpers Ferry, West Virginia; **Woodstock**, Baltimore, Maryland; **Old Dominion**, Lynchburg, Virginia; **Flatwoods** (all male) and **Blue Ridge** (all female) Southwest Virginia.

## What is Job Corps?

Job Corps is America's oldest, largest and most comprehensive residential training program for youths aged 17 - 24. Job Corps was established in 1964 and is administered by the Department of Labor.

The mission of this federally funded program continues to be "to assist young individuals to become more responsible, employable and productive citizens."
